## Overview

**Insight Academy** is an **advisory** and **capability-building** program and consists of two programs:

In the first program (start-up/spin-off support program), it helps scientific organisations' <u>early-stage start-up and spin-off companies</u> relevant to contemporary <u>agrifood and health systems</u> by offering <u>support services</u> such as scale-up and consultancy on e.g. access to project funding opportunities, product development, etc.

In the second program (Insight Academy), it <u>offers to scientific organisations' academic and non-academic staff interested in spinning off innovative companies insights</u> into the complexity of food and health systems, state-of-the-art technologies and innovations, actual needs of industries and customers/patients, sectorial regulations, and funding and capital market for innovative start-ups by professionals working in the field of food and health innovations from industry, academia and European institutions. Participants will gain insights into emerging food and health technologies and research trends, becoming equipped with knowledge needed to contribute and better develop their innovation eco-systems through the creation and operation of more sustainable and competitive start-up and spin-off companies related to food and health sectors.

Insight Academy is part of the <u>InterHEI</u> project, a pan-European consortium realizing the Interdisciplinary HEI Entrepreneurship Fostering Program. The InterHEI, under the leadership of the University of Warsaw, brings together consortium partners from Greece, Italy, Poland, Serbia, Slovakia, Spain, Turkey, and Ukraine, providing high-quality knowledge and best practices in the food and health area.

## **Beneficiaries**

- The Insight Academy is focused on supporting early-stage academic start-up/spin-off companies;
- The start-up/spin-off company must have at least **one co-founder working at scientific organisations** (universities or research institutes);
- The start-up/spin-off company must be registered and operates in one of the countries or regions covered by the EIT Regional Innovation Scheme (see the full list of countries and regions <u>HERE</u>);
- The start-up/spin-off companies' core business must fall under one of the EIT Food innovation focus areas (please see the list <u>HERE</u>) or be related to innovation in health sector, e.g. such as dietary supplements, nutraceuticals, food safety;
- **Priority** will be given to start-up/spin-off companies of the scientific organisations participating in <u>InterHEI project</u>, which are: University of Warsaw (Poland), Lodz University of Technology (Poland), Universidad Loyola (Spain), Marmara University (Turkey), Perrotis College (Greece), Science Park Kyiv National Taras Shevchenko University (Ukraine), Medical University of Lodz (Poland), University of Agriculture in Krakow (Poland), Slovak University of Agriculture in Nitra (Slovakia), Institute of Food Technology (Serbia) and Scientific and Technological Research Institution of Turkey (TÜBİTAK).
